



Vaccination Guideline



Please protect your best friend

One of the most important things you can do to give your dog a long and healthy life is to ensure he or she is vaccinated against common canine diseases. Be sure to follow vaccination guidelines to determine the vaccines needed to protect your dog.

Why vaccinate your dog?

During the first few weeks after birth, your dog receives disease fighting cells and proteins called antibodies in his or her mother's milk, which provided immunity from disease. After this period, vaccines are needed to protect your dog against disease.

How do vaccines work

Vaccines contain small quantities of altered or killed viruses, bacteria or other disease causing organisms that stimulate your dog's immune system to produce antibodies.
